Quick Tips

The cooler months are here and your furnace will be starting up again, if not already. The first time you turn your heat on, you may notice a burning smell and your smoke alarms may want to chirp.

Though it may be alarming, this is completely normal. The dust build up on your system from the summer months is being burned off by the heat of your furnace. This burning of dust remnants should only last for approximately 10 minutes and only occurs on the first startup of your heating system.

In addition, for the up coming cooler months, firewood will continue to be supplied once a month for our residents. The wood will be located near the fire pit and picnic area and is free to all residents.

The 1st delivery of firewood will be approximately a week or two from



Thanksgiving, and then a week or two before Christmas.

Should you wish to use your fireplace, please feel free to take what you need, and please be courteous to your neighbors so that there will be enough for all to enjoy.

Pet Policies

We wanted to give a few reminders regarding our pet policies here at Tide Mill.

1. Please remember that all pets of any kind must be registered with the office upon arrival in the community. If they are visiting, please inform the office so no additional charges are applied to your account.
2. There is a onetime pet fee of \$250 and a monthly pet rent of \$25 per pet. We also have a weight guideline of 65 lbs.
3. Remember to keep your pets leashed and under your control at all times while you are outdoors. We do have a designated pet park area that pets are welcome to be off their leash.
4. Lastly, make sure to **immediately** pick up your pet's waste. Several pet stations are located throughout the community. If you are seen not cleaning up, you will be fined.

Owning a pet is a privilege and an important responsibility. Please help keep our community a safe and clean environment for all to enjoy.
