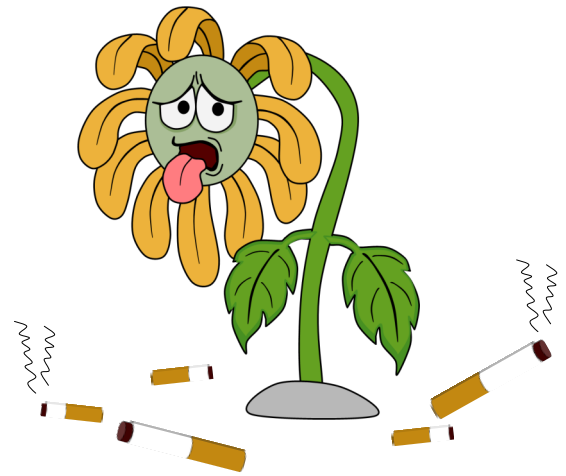
## Quick Tips

Did you know that cigarette butts are the most littered item in America and the world?

It is estimated that several trillion cigarette butts are littered worldwide every year. That's billions of cigarettes flicked, one at a time, on our sidewalks, beaches, nature trails, gardens, and other public places every single day.

Cigarette filters are made of cellulose acetate tow, NOT COTTON, and they can take decades to degrade. Not only does cigarette litter ruin even the most picturesque setting, but the toxic residue in cigarette filters is damaging to the environment, can injure or even kill animals that think it is food, and actually cause numerous fires every year, some of them fatal.

We have tried to take this situation lightly, but unfortunately when it comes to the issue of the cigarette litter, it is no laughing matter. We would like to keep our community clean, and healthy, and



above all, respect all of our neighbors. All it takes it a second of effort and an ashtray that can cost as little as \$1.00 to alleviate this issue.

If you have no ashtray, you can “field strip” your cigarette by knocking out the loose tobacco and paper, ensuring that the remaining filter and paper are completely extinguished, and then throw it in the nearest trashcan, not on the ground!

Each time you light up, consider how you will dispose of your cigarette beforehand. For smokers and non-smokers, spreading the word to others is very important.

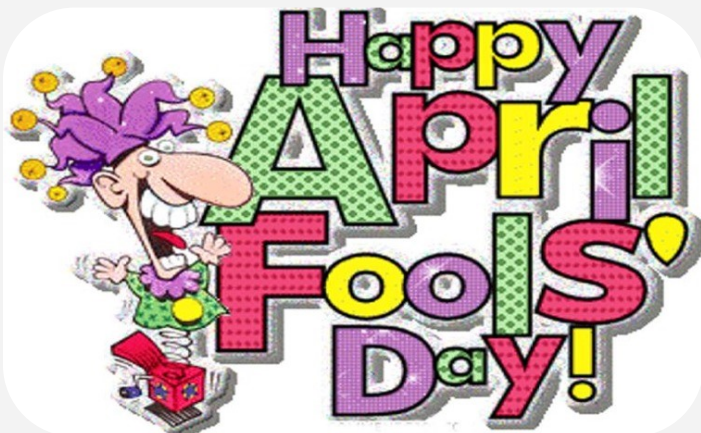


April 17th, 2015 is the next 3rd Friday in Downtown Salisbury, and just in time for a Spring Celebration!
